Missouri Concealed Carry Weapon (CCW) classes are taught by JR Marketing/The Gun Shop. This class fulfills the mandatory training requirement of Missouri State Statute RSMo 571.111.2. Special emphasis is made on weapons safety in and outside of the home. Instruction on the basic principles of marksmanship and the care and cleaning of firearms is covered. Missouri legal requirements for certification and laws relating to concealed carry, and justifiable use of force are also included in the class. The course is handicapped accessible.

A total of eight (8) hours of instruction is divided between an interactive lecture and live fire range training. The cost of the class is \$100.00 per student. This price includes gun use if needed, a complete course manual and Lunch.

You will need one (1) double action revolver and one (1) semi-automatic pistol and about 200 rounds of ammunition. No single action revolvers (cowboy style) will be allowed. Also required are hearing and eye protection, a cap/hat with a bill and appropriate clothing. No open toe shoes or sandals are allowed.

Upon successful completion, each graduate will be issued a certificate of Firearms Safety Training that meets the requirements for the Missouri Concealed Carry license application, as well as a certificate suitable for hanging.

Applications are accepted on a first come, first confirmed basis. Applicants are **ONLY** considered registered when all fees have been received. The enclosed forms maybe completed and brought with you on the day of the class.

Please be sure you have read and understand all the information contained in the enclosed registration and waiver forms. If you have any further questions or comments, please call or email us.

## What to Expect & What to Bring to the CCW Class

Roll will be taken at **JR Marketing/The GunShop at 9:00am**, if you need to make any purchases please arrive no earlier than 8:30 am. Doors will **NOT** be opened until 8:30am. All registration and payments must be handled before the day of class unless prior arrangements have been made. Please be on time and don't forget to check in.

If you plan on using your guns please bring with you one (1) double action revolver and one (1) semi-automatic pistol. **\*NOTE: firearms with any modifications or scopes will not be allowed.** Bring approximately 200 rounds of factory ammunition for your firearms. **No reloaded ammunition.**

If you do not own both types of firearms (revolver & semi-auto), you may use our Range Guns; you will need to purchase 200 rounds of ammunition from us the day of class; please arrive early to do so.

Bring hearing and eye protection and a cap/hat with a bill for the range session. All items needed will be available for purchase should you need them the day of the class. Dress casually and comfortable in appropriate clothing (No shorts, low cut or tank tops). No open toe shoes or sandals are allowed. If you arrive dressed inappropriate for the range session you will be asked to leave.

**ABSOLUTELY NO FIREARMS OR AMMUNITION WILL BE ALLOWED IN THE CLASSROOM. DO NOT BRING CHILDREN, GUESTS OR ANIMALS WITH YOU.**

There will be several breaks during the classroom sessions. Lunch will be provided along with bottled water and sodas. Full restroom facilities are adjacent to the classroom. Unless otherwise announced the classroom and restrooms are handicapped accessible. All classroom materials and targets will be provided. Please set all cell phones and pagers to "silent" or "vibrate" during the class session.

Safety rules will be enforced **AT ALL TIMES**. You are expected to know and follow the enclosed "Range Rules" Any breach of the range rules may result in your dismissal from the class with no refund.

### **\*\*\*Refund Policy\*\*\***

The course fee is not refundable if the course is not attended or is not completed successfully due to inability to pass. Students will be given at least one other range session in which to successfully complete the live fire portion of the class.

Students that are dismissed from a session due to a breach in the range rules will not be issued a refund and will not be allowed to attend another session.

If, due to an unforeseen emergency, a registered student is unable to attend the fee will be credited towards a future class.



## Range Rules

THE FOLLOWING RANGE RULES ARE TO BE STRICTLY FOLLOWED. ALL WEAPONS ARE SUBJECT TO INSPECTION BY THE RANGE MASTER AT ANY TIME.

1. Treat all weapons as though they were loaded.
2. Never point a firearm at anyone unless you are justified in doing so.
3. All firearms training will be properly supervised by the range master/officer.
4. Strictest discipline must be maintained. Carelessness and horseplay will not be tolerated.
5. When picking up a firearm, open the cylinder or action to assure it is not loaded. Check it again!
6. Never give or take from another person, a firearm, unless the cylinder/action is open.
7. Never anticipate a command.
8. Be sure there are no obstruction(s) in the barrel of a firearm before loading.
9. Load and/or unload only when and where instructed.
10. Keep the firearm pointed down range at all times.
11. Never draw or re-holster a weapon with finger inside the trigger guard.
12. No smoking while on the firing line.
13. No talking while on the firing line.
14. Never permit the muzzle of a firearm to touch the ground.
15. In case of misfire, keep muzzle pointed down range at least 10 seconds before opening the action.
16. Never fire a succeeding shot after a malfunction without checking the barrel for obstructions.
17. Never go in front of the firing line unless instructed to do so by the range master/officer.
18. Never carry a loaded firearm onto the range unless instructed.
19. Never dry fire on the range except under the supervision of the range master/officer.
20. Pay strict attention to the range master/officer at all times. He will instruct you when and what to do at all times.
21. Eye and ear protection is mandatory.
22. All accepted safety precautions will be strictly adhered to.

ANY BREACH OF THESE RANGE RULES MAY RESULT IN THE IMMEDIATE DISMISSAL FROM THE CLASS WITH NO REFUND.

**Missouri CCW Applicant Requirements**  
**RSMo 571.101.2**

A certificate of qualification for a concealed carry endorsement issued pursuant to subsection 7 of this section shall be issued by the sheriff or his or her designee of the county or city in which the applicant resides, if the applicant:

- (1) Is at least twenty-one years of age, is a citizen of the United States and either:
  - (a) Has assumed residency in this state; or
  - (b) Is a member of the armed forces stationed in Missouri, or the spouse of such member of the military;
- (2) Has not pled guilty to or entered a plea of nolo contendere or been convicted of a crime punishable by imprisonment for a term exceeding one year under the laws of any state or of the United States other than a crime classified as a misdemeanor under the laws of any state and punishable by a term of imprisonment of one year or less that does not involve an explosive weapon, firearm, firearm silencer or gas gun;
- (3) Has not been convicted of, pled guilty to or entered a plea of nolo contendere to one or more misdemeanor offenses involving crimes of violence within a five-year period immediately preceding application for a certificate of qualification for a concealed carry endorsement or if the applicant has not been convicted of two or more misdemeanor offenses involving driving while under the influence of intoxicating liquor or drugs or the possession or abuse of a controlled substance within a five-year period immediately preceding application for a certificate of qualification for a concealed carry endorsement;
- (4) Is not a fugitive from justice or currently charged in an information or indictment with the commission of a crime punishable by imprisonment for a term exceeding one year under the laws of any state of the United States other than a crime classified as a misdemeanor under the laws of any state and punishable by a term of imprisonment of two years or less that does not involve an explosive weapon, firearm, firearm silencer, or gas gun;
- (5) Has not been discharged under dishonorable conditions from the United States armed forces;
- (6) Has not engaged in a pattern of behavior, documented in public records, that causes the sheriff to have a reasonable belief that the applicant presents a danger to himself or others;
- (7) Is not adjudged mentally incompetent at the time of application or for five years prior to application, or has not been committed to a mental health facility, as defined in section 632.005, RSMo, or a similar institution located in another state following a hearing at which the defendant was represented by counsel or a representative;
- (8) Submits a completed application for a certificate of qualification as defined in subsection 3 of this section;
- (9) Submits an affidavit attesting that the applicant complies with the concealed carry safety training requirement pursuant to subsections 1 and 2 of section 571.111;
- (10) Is not the respondent of a valid full order of protection which is still in effect.

**RELEASE, HOLD HARMLESS, INDEMNIFICATION,  
ASSUMPTION OF RISK, WAIVER AGREEMENT**

**WHEREAS**, in return for instruction in firearms, use of premises, and other good and valuable consideration, the receipt and sufficiency of which is hereby acknowledged, the Undersigned agrees to indemnify, hold harmless and defend JR Marketing (to include Jeffry M. Campbell, David L. Slavens and James H. Burkhart, singularly or collectively) and any of its employees, directors, officers, or agents (hereinafter "JR Marketing"), from any and all discharge of firearms, the course of instruction, the Undersigned's participation in the course of instruction, the range, buildings, land and premises used for the course of instruction (hereinafter the "premises"), the Undersigned's presence on or use of said premises, and any and all acts or omissions of the Undersigned. And should any such claim, demand, or lawsuit arise or be asserted in any way whatsoever related thereto, whether arising under the laws of the United States or any State, or under any theory of law or equity, the Undersigned will indemnify, hold harmless and defend JR Marketing, from any or all costs, expenses, or liability including, but not limited to, the cost of any settlement or judgment made or rendered against JR Marketing, whether individually, jointly, or in so lido with the Undersigned, together with all the cost of court and other costs or expenses in connection with any such claim, demand, or lawsuit, including attorney's fees.

The Undersigned furthermore waives for himself/herself and his/her executors, administrators, assignees or heirs, any and all rights and claims for damages, losses, demands, and other actions whatsoever, which may have or which may rise against JR Marketing (including, but not limited to any and all injuries, damages, or illness suffered by the Undersigned or Undersigned's property), which may, in any way whatsoever, arise out of, be related to or be connected with: the course of instruction, the premises, including latent defect in the premises, the Undersigned's presence on or use of said premises, the Undersigned's property (whether or not entrusted to JR Marketing), and the discharge of firearms. JR Marketing shall not be liable for, and the Undersigned, on behalf of himself/herself and his/her executors, administrators, assignees or heirs, hereby expressly releases JR Marketing from any and all such claims.

The Undersigned furthermore hereby expressly and voluntarily assumes the risk of entering the premises and taking part in activities on the premises, which include, but not limited to, instruction in the use of firearms, the discharge of firearms and the firing of live ammunition.

***IF YOU HAVE ANY DOUBT ABOUT THE MEANING OR CONTENT OF THIS INSTRUMENT, CONSULT AN ATTORNEY PRIOR TO SIGNING.*** This instrument binds the Undersigned and his/her executors, administrators, assignees or heirs.

**I affirm that I am of legal age to participate in this training and can legally possess handguns.**

I furthermore recognize that JR Marketing/The GunShop is not obligated to allow me to participation in firearms safety training and that they may discontinue my participation at any time and require me leave without a refund.

I furthermore acknowledge and agree that I have read and understand the "Range Rules" and "What to expect & What to Bring to the CCW class".

I understand that the term I, me, myself, you and Student all refer to the party signing this instrument as "undersigned" and is a student in the firearms instruction class offered by JR Marketing/The GunShop.

I have read and understand the foregoing provisions and I have executed this instrument voluntarily and knowingly on the below listed date.
